"I miss school, I would be in grade five next year, I don't know whether I will ever go back to school. My parents think I should get married!" This is what we are hearing from our children.

Since the closure of schools in Uganda in March, there has been deafening silence as to when, if at all, the school year will be salvaged before December 31, 2020. While waiting for the government decision about the reopening of schools, ALDO has been engaging people on the ground to prepare for the reopening.

Children of Amazing Love School:

ALDO is aware that to balance our response to the pandemic for school reopening and look beyond the crisis, requires new ways of thinking. In addition to the need for digital transformations, ALDO is considering the social and academic impact on the children with regard to the rise in school dropout rates, early marriages, poor nutrition, interrupted learning... the list goes on especially amongst the children like those of the Amazing Love school.

A survey conducted by the chair of the School Management Board revealed the despair among the children. Many of these children have not been able to access radio or TV lessons offered by the government. Because of the curfew and need for social distancing, it has not been feasible to prepare materials for individual children. These children have been out of school for over five months! ALDO reproduced some reading materials for the upper grades, but there is no way of assessing whether children understood the content of the materials.

Teachers of Amazing Love School:

Without jobs and salaries, teachers are under pressure to find ways of supporting their families. We read the Ugandan local newspapers with daily articles of how many teachers have given up hope of ever returning to work. Some have branched to casual labor to survive.

The teachers were supported until April with full salaries. So far, the teachers are being helped with food and beans...

How ALDO is preparing for the reopening:

Water Source:

ALDO has secured money to replace the dried-up borehole and provide a reliable water source. Work will be starting in September, thanks to the ETFO Humanity Fund.

Single Seater Desks:

ALDO has increased the number of single desks from 20 to 90. This is in addition to the four-seater desks which will be allowed to accommodate only two students. We still need to make an additional 60 single seater desks to accommodate all the children and comply with the COVID-19 restrictions.

Face Masks:

ALDO has secured 600 facemasks ahead of reopening to help both the staff and students. More masks will be required once the schools open.

Digital capture of instructional Materials:

Prior to COVID-19, our teachers used to write their long- range plans, day plans and notes in notebooks and planning books. ALDO wanted to modernize the process to save time in handwriting the notes.

In preparation for re-opening, we invited teachers back, five at a time, to digitize their instructional materials using the school laptops. The first cohort will finish on September 12, 2020.

Repairs and Maintenance:

- a) ALDO has completed the installation of 50 windows and 8 door glass panes in the dining hall and the day care. We have also replaced 15 broken windows that had not been replaced since 2015.
- b) Work is under way to repair a crack that developed in the teachers' pit latrine.
- c) Due to the heavy rains, the grass grows so fast. Almost every three weeks we need to cut the grass.

Our New Website: Amazing Love Development Organization

ALDO has modernized its website to make it more appealing and easier to understand. ALDO has conducted a full redesign of our website to stay modern to make it more userfriendly.

Applying for Charitable Status:

ALDO is grateful to the Uganda Relief and Development Organization (URDO) for taking ALDO under their umbrella since 2009. Thanks, URDO, especially Mr. George Okurapa for all the sacrifice you have made to help ALDO to succeed.

ALDO is currently applying for a charitable status. Once successful, ALDO will issue the tax receipts to all our donors, but we look forward to continuing to work with and learn from URDO.

COVID-19 RESPONSE

COMPLETING THE STOREYED BUILDING:

This building is very essential as we do not have a lot of land to expand. The second and third levels will house the administration office, girls' dormitory, and additional classrooms. With COVID-19 issues, we shall need extra classrooms to be able to practice safe distancing. Boys will be moved to the current dormitory used by girls.

IMMEDIATE COVID-19 REQUIREMENTS

Protective measures must be in place before the schools can re-open. These will have major financial implications as the school has many children. Some of the measures include:

a) Recruitment:

- School Nurse This is part of the School Health Policy.
- Additional Teachers will be required if we must divide classes into two or three groups to allow for physical distancing.
- School Cleaners will be required to ensure the classes are thoroughly and regularly cleaned and all common surfaces sanitized.
- School Bursar As the school has expanded, there is need for a dedicated person to handle finances. Up until now, we have relied on the service of one of the teachers, but we require her services back in the classroom.
- School Matron and Patron to help the boarding school children. This is especially important with the COVID-19 challenges.
- b) **Construction of a sick bay:** to provide an isolation unit for sick children (especially those in the boarding section)
- c) Regular cleaning supplies like soap, brushes, disinfectants, etc.
- d) Fire extinguishers for the boarding section
- e) Additional handwashing water tanks placed in different locations for all people entering the school grounds.
- f) Construction of additional classrooms: social distancing will require additional space to ensure that children keep a safe distance. Additionally, some classes will take place outside, which is very normal for our area.
- g) Student desks: Currently, four children use one desk. We may need to have two children per desk. Many more desks will be needed to allow for social distancing.
