ALDO BOARD

In late October 2020, the ALDO Board hosted a Virtual Taste of Africa via Zoom that showcased African cooking, updates from our Board President and school founders along with videos of our teachers and students. We received overwhelming encouraging feedback regarding this event.

Overall, attendees enjoyed hearing directly from the teachers and students. Many of our supporters have never had the opportunity to travel to Uganda to meet the children in person, so having the opportunity to hear the children's concerns about the pandemic and thoughts on their education was very much appreciated. We are incredibly appreciative of the funds raised, which came to just over \$11,000.







STRATEGIC PLAN

Our 5-year Strategic Plan was drafted and finalized this fall. This plan outlines our goal to continue to expand access to quality education, training, and leadership skills to the children of Nakyere and surrounding villages in Namutumba District to help them achieve their full potential. Additionally, we will continue to provide access to school and hands-on skills training to children who would otherwise go without, due to harsh living conditions.

This plan has been carefully crafted to identify gaps in the sustainability of not only the school and our academic achievement as a student body, but also of the village. We have researched, outlined, and approved special projects to improve outcomes for the children and families in the village. Some of these projects are already underway, like our rabbit farm, which will teach the children about raising livestock, and provide the children with meat for consumption and for sale.

OUR OWN EXAM CENTRE

We are happy to report that Amazing Love School was granted the status of an Examination Center. Our children will take their 2021 exams from the school.

ALDO MEMBERSHIP

Join the ALDO Board to get involved in changing not only the lives of our students, but also the generations to come. We are reaching out to all our supporters to join the membership drive that we are introducing this year. OTHER VOLUNTEERS

ALDO is seeking to strengthen its Board of Directors with individuals with unique skills and experience necessary to take the organization through the next stage in its exciting development. ALDO is looking for the following skills:

- a) Information Technology to help with our website and online fundraising projects.
- b) **Leadership and Strategy** to help with the strategic planning and direction.
- c) **Project Management** to help with sustainable projects and capital development.
- d) Charity Lawyer to help with legal issues.
- e) Public Relations, Marketing, and Administration.

SCHOOL PROJECTS

ALDO will be engaged in income generating projects to supplement the funds raised through fundraising and the nominal contributions made by the parents. Some of the projects include:

- Goats, rabbits, and chicken
- Renting land for farming
- Constructing a granary to store grains when in season (the prices are cheaper)

SECURITY

There is no fencing around the school which makes it extremely difficult for the security personnel to ensure proper safety of school property, staff, and children. Fencing is urgently needed around the school.

CONSTRUCTION

- A perimeter wall has been constructed around the girls' dormitory to enhance security of the girls. It encloses the pit latrines and the newly constructed bathroom and the lavatory.
- The Storied building has been plastered on the outside wall and to prevent the rainwater from seeping into the foundation, the verandah around the building is being built.
- The floors, walls, and ventilation of the teachers' quarters need some maintenance work. We have also started painting their rooms after the solar installation.

COVID-19 RESPONSE

COMPLETING THE STOREYED BUILDING

This building is very essential as we do not have a lot of land to expand horizontally. The second and third levels will house the administration office, girls' dormitory, and additional classrooms. With COVID-19 issues, we shall need extra classrooms to be able to practice safe distancing. Boys will be moved to the current dormitory used by girls.

COVID-19 PROGRESS

Covid-19 will go down in history as a time of great indecisiveness. Uganda grappled with the consequences of re-opening the schools. Uganda re-opened school for the candidate classes only on October 15, 2020. For Amazing Love School, this is grade seven only.

Several purchases were made including 5 foot-operated soap dispensers, liquid soap for sanitation, sanitizers, thermometers, fire extinguishers in addition to first aid and school supplies.

To reduce exposure to Covid-19, the school only allowed boarding students. All Grade 7 children, 20 in total, (six boys and 14 girls) reported back to school. ALDO organized training for the students, parents, and staff. Both students and staff were provided with masks and all the other requirements.

STAFFING

We recalled four teachers to teach Grade 7. We also recruited a part-time school nurse, school cleaners, a school bursar, a Matron and Patron, and a project administrator to manage the coordination of Covid-19 metrics with the district, manage the water well drilling, installation of solar power, construction and repair and the projects we shall be starting.

OTHER STUDENTS

Since the closure of the school, students in rural regions have missed out on school. ALDO is considering photocopying a few passages for reading, laminate them and then have the students borrow them, so that they will continue improving in their reading skills.

COMPLETION OF THE GIRLS' DORMITORY

A six-foot protective wall was constructed to create a secure and private environment around the dormitory, 5 spacious bathrooms, curtain walls and the matron's accommodation.

SOLAR POWER IN THE STAFF QUARTERS

Solar power has been installed in the entire teachers' quarters inside with security lights outside, and some rooms painted.

FEEDING

The school plans to rent additional land and use it to grow corn, beans, sweet potatoes, cassava, and vegetables. Weather permitting, this will provide the teachers and students with more nutritious meals.

THE WATER WELL

The water well will be drilled from December 17, 2020 to December 23, 2020. That will be a great relief as the village gets into the dry season.

TEACHER SPONSORSHIPS
