Sheilagh and her niece Angel visited the school for 10 days and provided the following:

- Sports jerseys, the 2022 FIFA balls and other balls.
- 96 Mathematical sets for grades five to grade seven.
- Hot wheel cars for boys, tags for girls and all children received pencils.
- Bought food to help the hungry and sick children cope with their studies.

ETFO has provided support for the Amazing Love School project with \$10,000. This money is designated for a girls' dormitory. We hope to raise additional funds to start the construction of an additional dorm. The first one accommodates 30 girls, and it is already full. The boys' dorm is also soon reaching full capacity.

The Rotary Club of Ajax donated \$2,000 towards the kindergarten. We have so far made 15 tables and 16 benches, two chalk boards, two storage cabinets, two chairs and two tables for teachers. We making 14 additional benches, and will buy cups for the students.
