Hello again Amazing Love friends and supporters. As February leaves us, we can't help but turn our minds to a return to outdoor activities. For the children of the Amazing Love School, spring means the beginning of the rainy season (March until May). But this year, spring also brings with it new opportunities for our students.



In our September 2022 newsletter, we told you about two Ontario high school teachers, Michelle Massaro and Sara Hansen, (founders of Just Cause Education Outreach) who visited the school to educate the students on the wonderful world of robotics. They spent two days teaching the students how to assemble and then program robots using coding. Despite these skills being new concepts to the students, they caught on immediately. Later this month, a team of 10 senior students, aged 11-14, will travel to Jinja, Uganda to compete in a robotics competition. We wish them well! National exams

Last November, 19 grade seven students completed their Uganda Primary Leaving Examinations. We are very proud to report that not only did all of them pass, but 3 of them passed in the top mark category (equivalent to an A or A+ here in Canada) while 15 passed in the B to B+ range and 1 passed in the C to C+ range. From here, these students are eligible to continue their education in the secondary schools.

Holiday Feeding Program

Everyone at ALDO wants to thank you for helping the children with food during the holidays. The program ran between December 15, 2022 and January 29, 2023 and provided a daily meal to an average of 80 children per day. We had days when there were more than 100 children plus participating staff members. The response to the program even enabled us to provide a special Christmas meal to the children.
