Unlike Canada, with its sometimes-never-ending precipitation and snow, Uganda will enter its driest season. After the school year ends on December 1st, we won't see the children again until the new academic year that starts in February. During this long break, we increase our outreach efforts to the children. For the next two months, our students may not have regular access to food the way they do at Amazing Love School.

Christmas in Uganda ...



The 2022 Christmas season was filled with a great deal of uncertainty. The Ebola outbreak in Uganda, forced the shutdown of all schools to minimize the spread of the virus. This resulted in the extension of an already difficult time period for our students who don't receive regular meals at home and are reliant upon the nutrition program running at Amazing Love School.

ALDO used the social media platforms to appeal for emergency funds to run a **Holiday Feeding and Christmas Meal program.** Within a week, you had contributed over \$2700, and fed over 100 children through the months of December and January and also provided the children with a nourishing Christmas day meal (something some of them have never had before).

ALDO is committed to supporting not only the educational needs of our students, but also their nutritional needs, so we are embarking upon an annual feeding program to give children regular access to food during the winter break. More than 60% of parents are unable to provide food for their children due to the frequent droughts, floods, and diseases.


