PARENTING CONFERENCE



To enhance parental responsibility and deepen our collaboration with families, we hosted a two-day conference for parents. The event featured a speaker who provided valuable strategies for raising children and strengthening family relationships both now and in the future. ROBOTICS CLUB

We had a visit from the Canadian sponsor of the robotics club, Michelle Massaro. She came with a team of four to introduce next year's topics that will be featured during the 2025 Robotics Competitions in Uganda. The students of Amazing Love have been working hard and in fact, her team was surprised that our school team is ahead of the program. Instead of learning from Michelle and her team, the students showed off some of the skills that they have already mastered.

Additionally, Michelle's team introduced another challenge that requires us to provide a laptop and software called Window Stay that is needed to run the tools provided and will help our students go to the next level of excellence in the robotics knowledge.

SOAP MAKING

Our students recently had a fantastic opportunity to learn how to make liquid soap. Mr. Waiswa, one of our dedicated teachers, guided them through the process step by step. By the end of the session, the students had produced two jerricans of liquid soap. They were also able to take some of the leftover soap home with them.

This practical experience offers numerous benefits:

Skill Development: Students gained valuable hands-on experience in soap-making, which can be a useful life skill and potential future interest.

Hygiene Improvement: The liquid soap produced will be used in the school for cleaning classrooms, latrines, and dormitories, enhancing overall cleanliness and hygiene.

Environmental Impact: By creating their own cleaning products, students are contributing to a reduction in plastic waste and promoting sustainability within the school.

Resource Efficiency: Utilizing homemade soap reduces costs and reliance on external suppliers, allowing funds to be redirected towards other important school needs.

This initiative not only equips students with practical skills but also supports a cleaner and more sustainable school environment.

DEEPENING STUDENT ENGAGEMENT

To enhance student involvement, we asked our students to identify critical issues affecting their learning experience. We then grouped them and tasked them with developing solutions for these challenges. The students raised concerns including time management, class attendance, hunger, and health, and proposed effective strategies to address these issues. Their practical and innovative suggestions surpassed our expectations. This initiative highlights Amazing Love School's commitment to fostering student empowerment and proactive problem-solving.



GIRLS DORMITORY



Significant progress has been made on the new girls' dormitory, which will accommodate 75 girls and include a room for the matron. The building has been fully plastered, with six doors and twelve windows already installed.

To provide boarding for the girls on our waiting list, we aim to complete the dormitory by January 2025, just in time for the new school year.

Here's what still needs to be constructed:

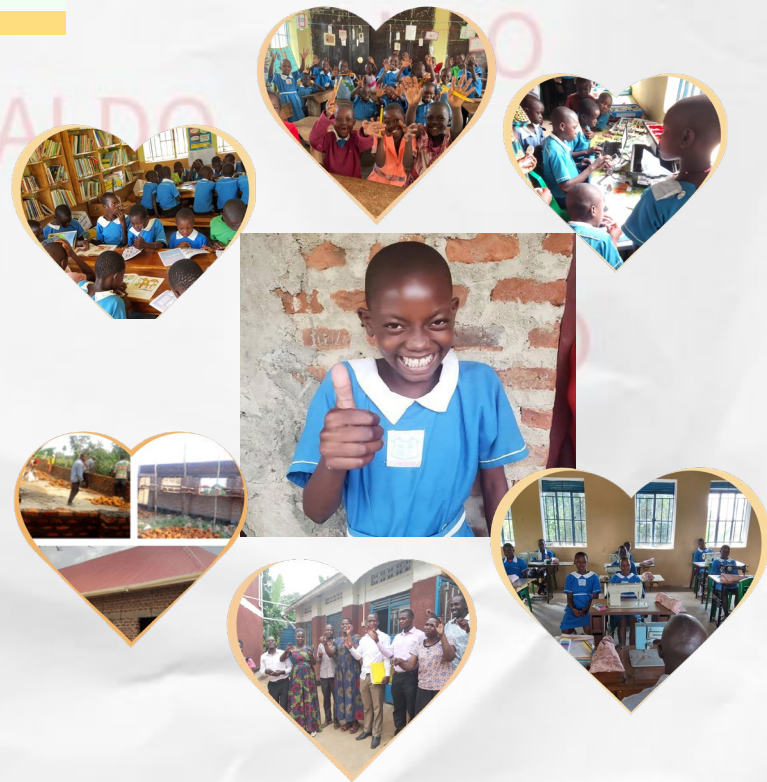
- Bathrooms, pit latrines, and laundry space
- A security wall around the dormitory
- Beds, an incinerator and storage facilities
- Solar power
- Water tank to harvest the rainwater
