As we head into another summer, our children are looking forward to a well-earned break from school. While the hallways of North American schools will be empty, the same is not true in Uganda. At Amazing Love School, our buildings are alive with the sounds of our students buckling down for their second term studies, which will run until August.

On behalf of the ALDO Board and the entire Amazing Love School community, thank you to everyone who responded so generously to our recent appeal. Together, we raised \$8,825; an incredible gift that allows us to pay salaries for 15 teachers and 5 support staff, and also feed the children for two months. Your ongoing support,



whether through student sponsorships, teacher support, volunteering, or other contributions, continues to change lives in profound ways. Many of our students, once facing a future without education, now rise each day with purpose and hope, knowing they are seen, valued, and empowered to dream, because of you.

With your support, we have grown steadily, year after year, into a thriving school with nearly 500 eager learners. ACTIVITIES AROUND THE SCHOOL

GIRL'S EMPOWERMENT PROGRAM

We are thrilled to announce that the new girls' dormitory is now complete and fully operational. The facility features:

- 8 bathrooms equipped with biodigester latrines
- Two spacious rooms accommodating 40–45 girls each
- A built-in room for the dorm matron

To ensure a safe, healthy, and efficient living environment, the dormitory also includes solar-powered lighting, handwashing sinks, water storage systems, and rough-cast walls for added durability. In a significant step towards safety, a perimeter wall topped with barbed wire has been constructed around the dorm. During a special visit, parents, PTA members, and school board officials toured the facility and praised its quality and positive impact on the girls' welfare.

BOYS' DORMITORY UPGRADES

The boys' dormitory has also received much-needed renovations. Improvements include repairs to both the interior and exterior walls, installation of new flooring, and a fully refurbished verandah. These upgrades provide a more secure and comfortable living environment for our male students.



















RESPONDING TO THE DROUGHT WITH RESILIENCE

The unusually long drought this year had a significant impact on our community, delaying critical rains and threatening both crops and livestock. Despite these challenges, Amazing Love School responded with determination and resourcefulness.

Thanks to our on-site water sources, we were able to protect our animals during the dry spell. When the rain finally arrived, we quickly planted beans and maize to recover some of the lost growing time. Additionally, with the help of our students, we harvested cassava and potatoes that had been planted last season, a testament to the power of preparation and teamwork.







SECURING THE SCHOOL AND FARMING GROUNDS

The extended drought brought unexpected challenges, including cattle from nearby areas trespassing onto school property in search of grass and water. At the same time, our own herd of 30 goats began roaming beyond school grounds due to broken fences. Unfortunately, this led to significant crop damage in nearby gardens, including those of our teachers and neighbors, resulting in heavy fines for the school.

In response, we constructed a secure perimeter fence around both the school and the farm, not only to prevent further incidents but also to meet government safety requirements. To support proper livestock management, we also planted specialized pasture grass and dug drainage to promote healthy growth and reduce roaming. These efforts have greatly improved safety, accountability, and community relations.



School Feeding Program for \$30 per term

Our Nutritional Program plays a vital role in supporting students who are deeply affected by the ongoing drought. Nakyere village relies heavily on farming, but with little to no rainfall, crop failure is common, leading to seasonal hunger. For many of our students, the one hot meal they receive at school through this program is their only meal of the day.

ALDO has been running this program for several years, thanks to the generosity of our sponsors and donors. However, the need is growing. We are asking for your continued support to keep this essential program alive and ensure that no child goes hungry. A donation of just \$30 is enough to feed one child for an entire school term. PRIMARY 7 ACADEMIC AWARDS


